NYC Added 62,000 Jobs over Past Year

- Employment in New York City rose by 62,000 from February 2011 to February 2012, led by a 30,300 gain in the professional and business services sector.
- A record number of visitors to the city helped drive employment higher in both the leisure and hospitality (+15,300), and trade, transportation and utilities (+11,900) sectors during this time.
- The only private-sector areas to lose jobs over the past year were construction (-3,300) and manufacturing (-2,300).

Stocks Have Best First Quarter Since 1998

- The S&P 500 index rose 12% in the first three months of 2012, its best first quarter in 14 years.
- Record company earnings, improving economic data, low interest rates and less concern over European debt levels all contributed to the strong quarter.
- The S&P 500 is now at its highest level in four years, and is up almost 30% since bottoming out in the beginning of October 2011.

Mortgage Rates Flat

- Rates for 30-year conforming mortgages averaged 3.99% in the week ending March 29th, according to Freddie Mac.
- This was down slightly from the prior week, and down from 4.86% a year ago.
