

#### NYC Adds 31,400 Jobs over Past Year

- Employment in New York City rose by just under 1% in the twelve months ending September, as 31,400 jobs were added.
- Gains continue to be led by education and health services (+18,100) and professional and business services (+17,500).
- · Construction saw the largest employment decline, losing 5,800 jobs over the past year.
